Spring has sprung; the days are lengthening and we are beginning to receive higher doses of vitamin D through the longer sunlight hours. There's something about this time of year, which is exciting and energising; lambs frolic in the paddocks, the ocean sparkling and the snapper start to feast ready to spawn in December.

Whilst there are holistic opportunities at school, like the Whangarei Primary Schools' Cross Country Race at Barge Park and junior class field trips to the stream, the focus is on seeking new knowledge and consolidating prior learning. Those learning goals set at the start of the year or amended at the midpoint, become very real at this time of year. Teachers are empowering their students to take responsibility for these goals, and where necessary, giving extra support to them to achieve these goals.

Last week, a group of about 10 teachers and parents met with Anna Gentry from Nature Play NZ to discuss some initial designs drawn up by her for our Junior Playground. This playground venture is going to be dedicated to our younger students at Parua Bay School - the Year 0-2 students. The "Nature-based" playground is planned to be constructed by the community to be ready for the first day of the new academic year in 2018. The plans for this playground project are on display and available to view in the front office of the school. Please have a look at these concept designs, and if you feel that this is something you would like to be a part of, please give your name to Linzi in the office along with any skills / resources / donations / you may be able to contribute towards this fabulous project. Anna from Nature Play NZ will co-ordinate this project and I am very excited at the prospect of the Parua Bay community really galvanising this venture with a huge local effort.

Finally, just to remind you to please fill in the Parua Bay School community survey that was sent out to all parents. The responses to this survey are analysed by the Board of Trustees and fed back to the staff at school via the Principal. As a profession, teachers are a very reflective bunch - we like to hear how we can improve our performance; however we also like to hear where we are doing well.

Rules for Disco


All children are to be picked up from inside the hall. Please make arrangements to pick up your child on time or have someone else do it for you.





Parua Bay School is hosting a 3 day Art Expo.

Enrolment Zone

In order to avoid overcrowding, or the likelihood of overcrowding, the board of Parua Bay School has adopted an enrolment scheme which has been approved by the Ministry of Education.

Under this scheme, students will be enrolled if they live within the home zone described below.

The zone starts at 335 Whangarei Heads Road and finishes at Craig Road including all properties on Whangarei Heads Road between these two points.

The zone also includes all properties on roads off Whangarei Heads Road between 335 Whangarei Heads Road and Craig Road excluding:

- Properties numbers 433 and below on Mt Tiger Road and
- Properties on the eastern side of Craig Road.

The enrolment of out of zone students is governed by the provisions of the Education Act 1989.

The enrolment scheme, which includes a precise description of the home zone, may be viewed at the school office, where copies of the scheme are also available.


