Although I have mentioned it before I will reiterate that being a Decile 9 school we are not given the same funds as lower decile schools (A decile 1 school of our size receives an extra quarter of a million dollars towards all resources than what we receive). Therefore we do rely heavily on parent school fees contributions and fundraising events to enable our tamariki to receive the best educational opportunities.

Improving all forms of communication between the school and whanau is one of the Senior Leadership Team's major goals this year. To that end, we are endeavouring to create really clear information channels so that, whichever medium parents choose to use, the message is consistent.
